

GREENHORN MOUNTAIN VETERANS ASSOCIATION (GMVA)

The GMVA was established in September of 1948 as a non-profit organization whose aim, then and now, is "to promote social activity and community welfare." The GMVA's solid history of community achievements began in 1948-49 when they were instrumental in convincing the Kern County Sheriff to assign a resident deputy to the Glennville area. In later years, they lobbied for both the development of Highway 155 from Delano to the Greenhorn Summit and the building of a county dump station. The GMVA also provided funds for maintenance in the historic Glennville Fire Station and their purchase of new equipment. Members of the GMVA have long been supporters of our local blood bank, providing life-saving blood to our community.

In more recent years, the GMVA has made its facilities available for local schools, churches and many community functions such as 4-H activities, ropings, and even weddings. In 2016 the rodeo grounds served as base camp for firefighters from around the United States as they battled the Cedar Fire in the Greenhorn Mountain area. We proudly host the Thomas Midnight Pewitt Memorial Scholarship Fund's annual ranch rodeo and local high school rodeo competitions.

This year, for our 72nd Annual Glennville Rodeo, we are again proudly teaming-up with the Lauren Small Benefit to support the Lauren Small Children's Medical Center and local charities for children's health.

In addition to serving these various community groups, the GMVA will always seek ways to support and honor our veterans and encourage our active military servicemen and women.

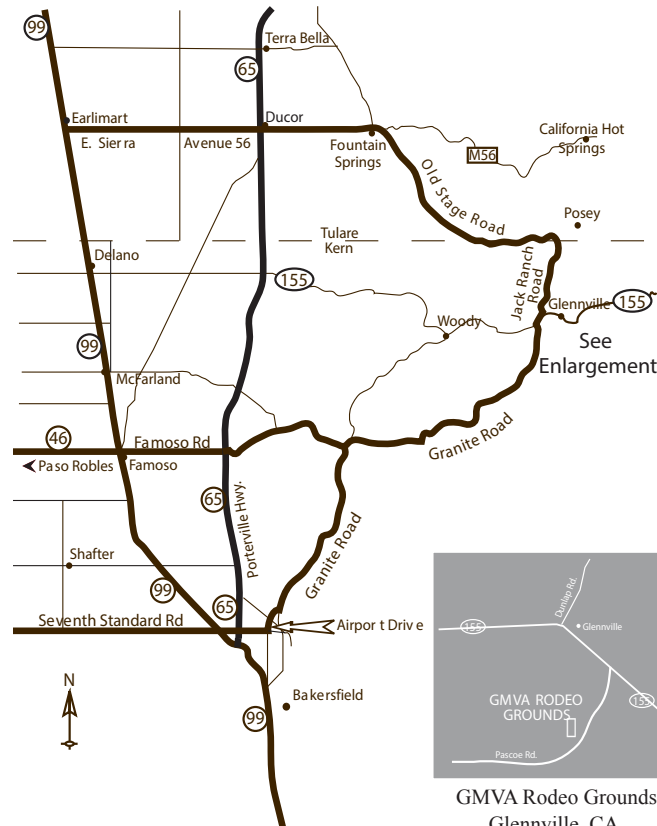
