## Wardrobe Requirements:

<b>Orientation</b>	<b>Casual Western (Wrangler jeans, long-sleeved blouse or jacket)</b> <i>with Contestant Sash</i>
<b>Speech &amp; Modeling</b>	<b>Western Dress Fashion Forward</b> <i>Note: We are not looking for expensive clothing, just attractive and stylish, suitable for an evening event. (NO Sash)</i>
<b>Personal Interviews</b>	<b>Western skirt or pantsuit with long-sleeved blouse and jacket.</b> <i>Note: You are going for a professional look, as if you were taking part in a job interview, but with a western twist. (NO Sash)</i>
<b>Horsemanship</b>	<b>Wrangler jeans with form-fitting long-sleeved blouse or shirt.</b> Shirt must be tucked in. No jackets, vests, chaps, or spurs. <b>(NO Sash)</b>
<b>Small Miracles Dinner</b>	<b>Western Dress (Skirt with long-sleeved blouse and jacket; long or short dress. "Fashion forward" is allowed)</b> <i>Note: We are not looking for expensive clothing, just attractive and stylish, suitable for an evening event. (Wear Contestant Sash)</i>
<b>Written Test</b>	<b>Casual Western (Wrangler jeans, long-sleeved blouse with vest or jacket)</b> <b>(Wear Contestant Sash)</b>
<b>Parade &amp; Rodeo</b>	<b>Arena Outfit (Wranglers and long-sleeved arena blouse)</b> <i>This is also the occasion to add some sparkle to your clothing!</i> <b>(Wear Contestant Sash)</b>
